STRINGLISH

Straight lines are drawn within a shape at different angles. These angles correspond to letters of the alphabet, the diagram at the bottom of the page shows how.

Where a line touches the shape that frames it, an origin (O) is established, ready for the next letter to be drawn.

The x-axis aligns with the frame's edge.

The frame can be any shape, but those that work best have interior angles greater than or equal to 90°, so a right angle Dots separate words, larger ones indicate capital letters.
